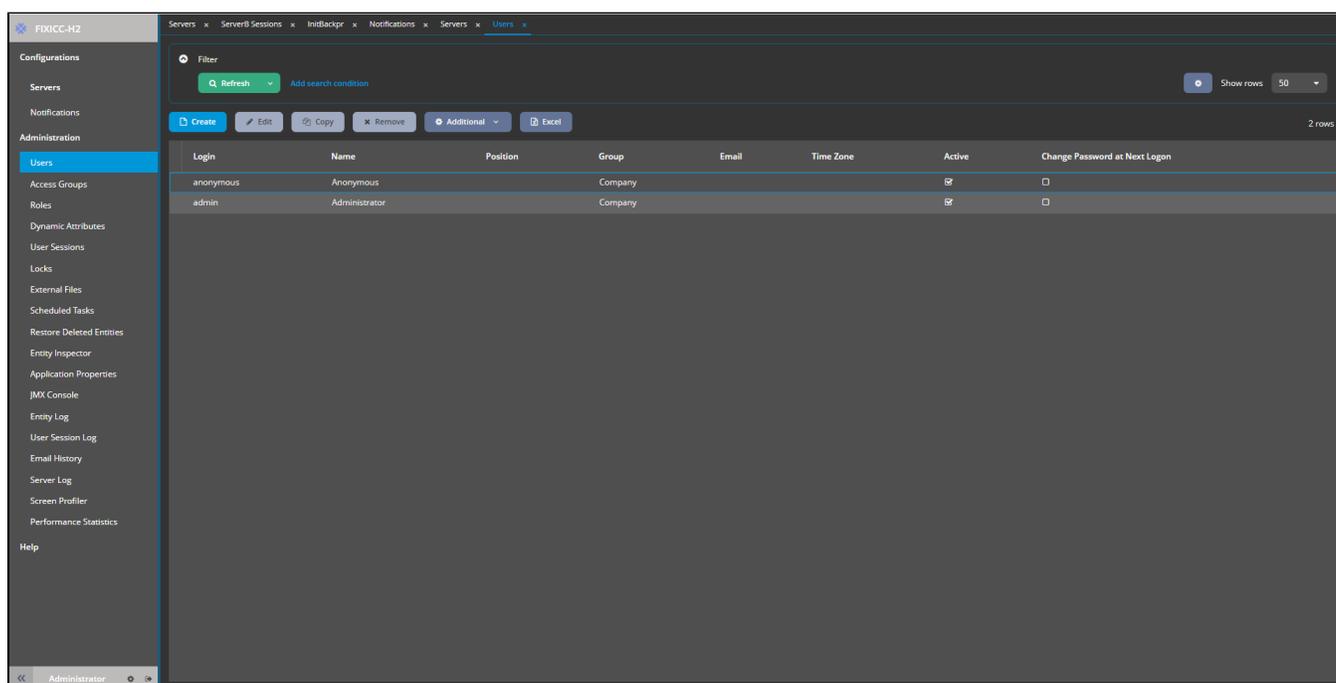

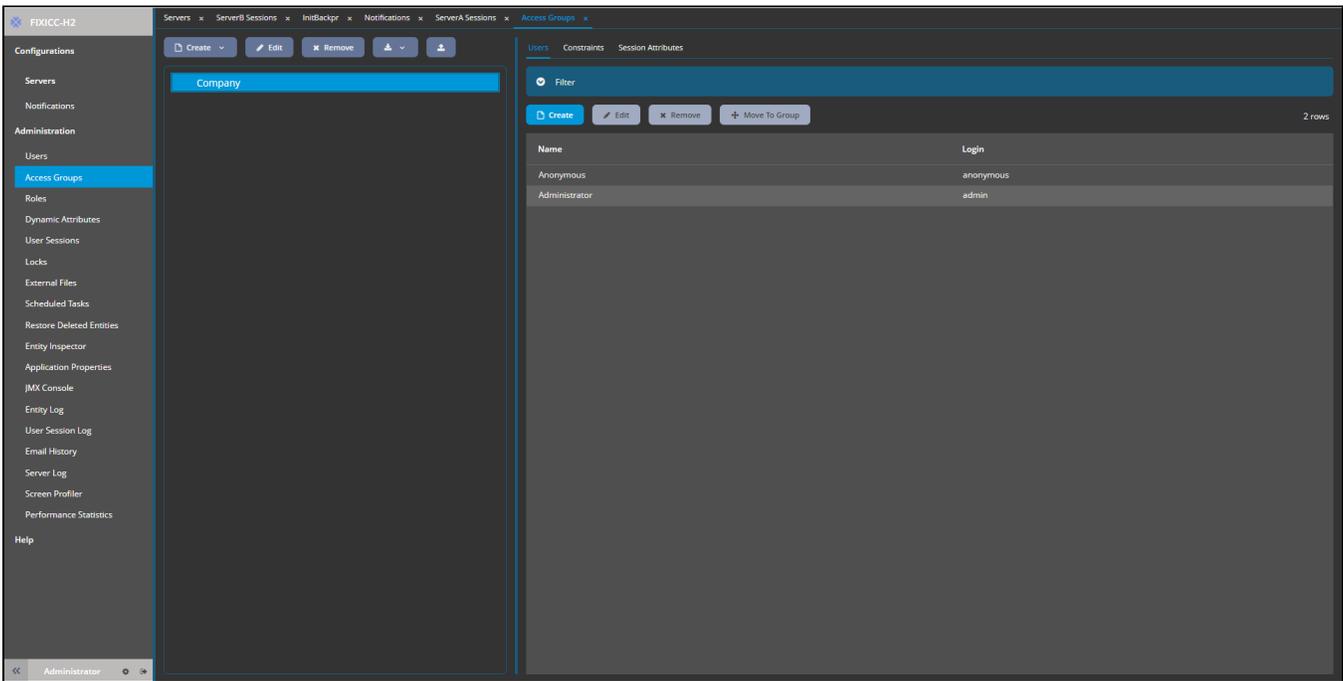


Figure. Access Groups.

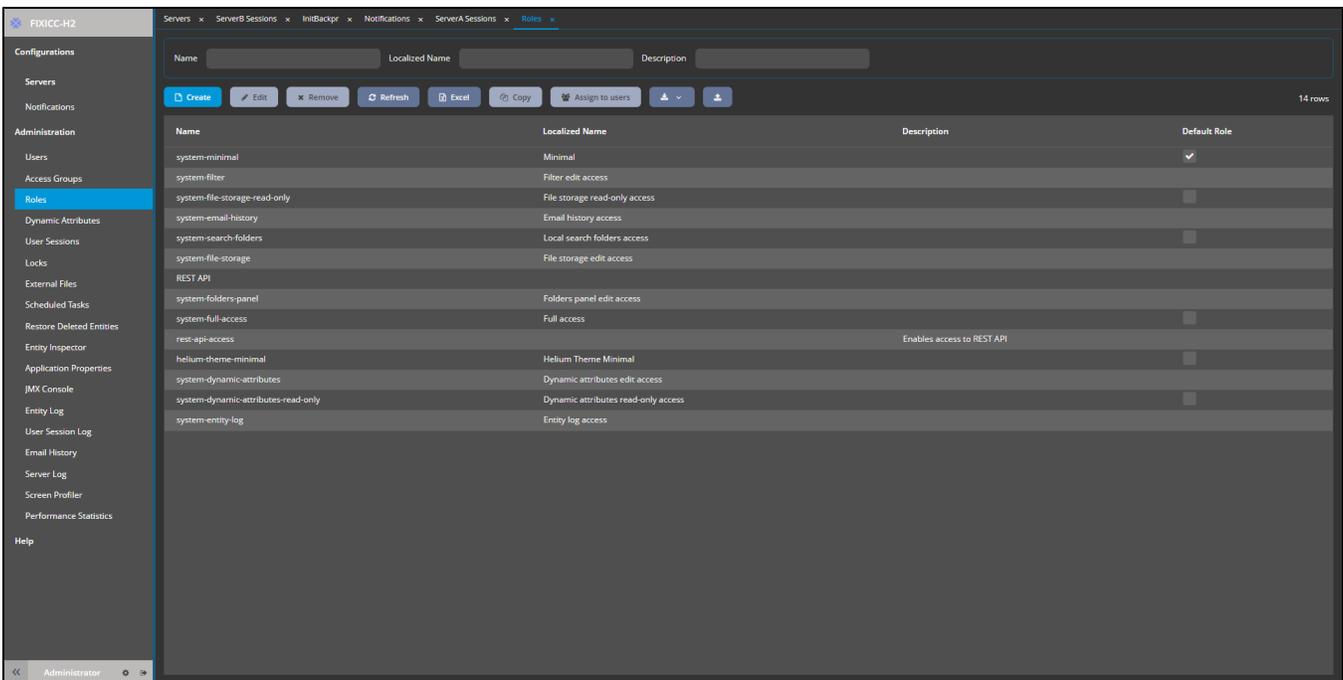


Figure. Roles.

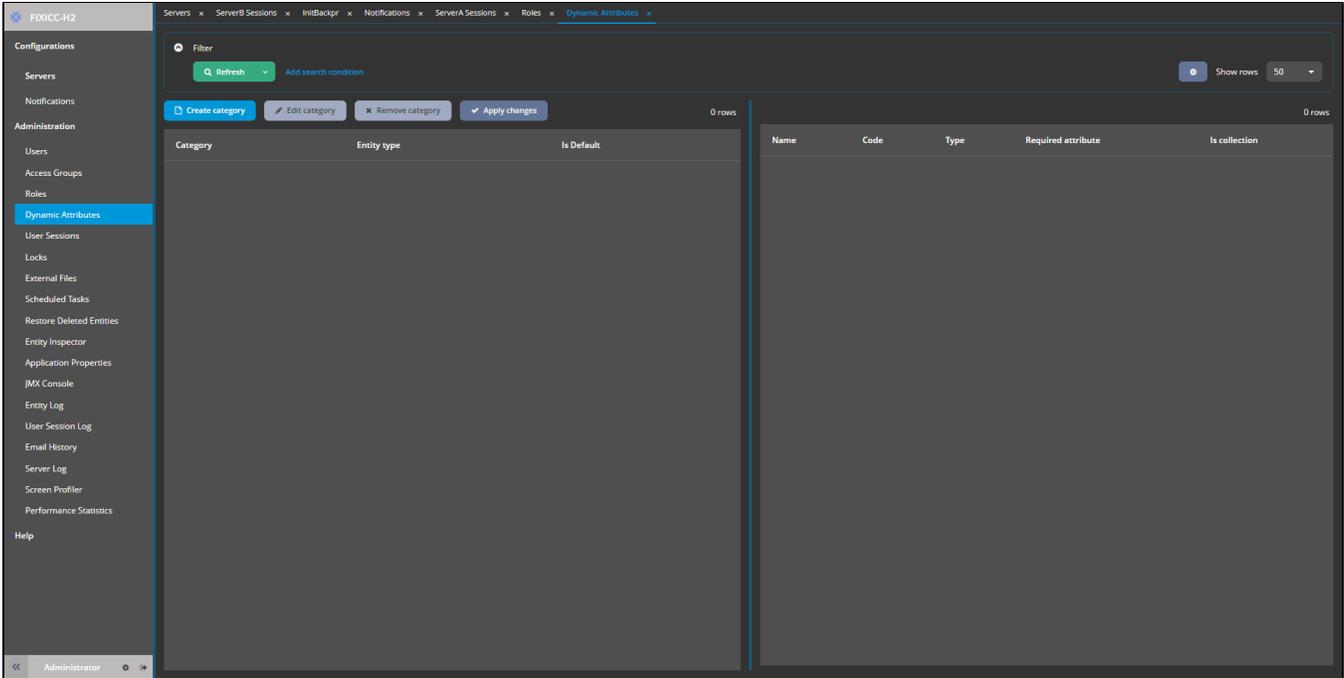


Figure. Dynamic Attributes.

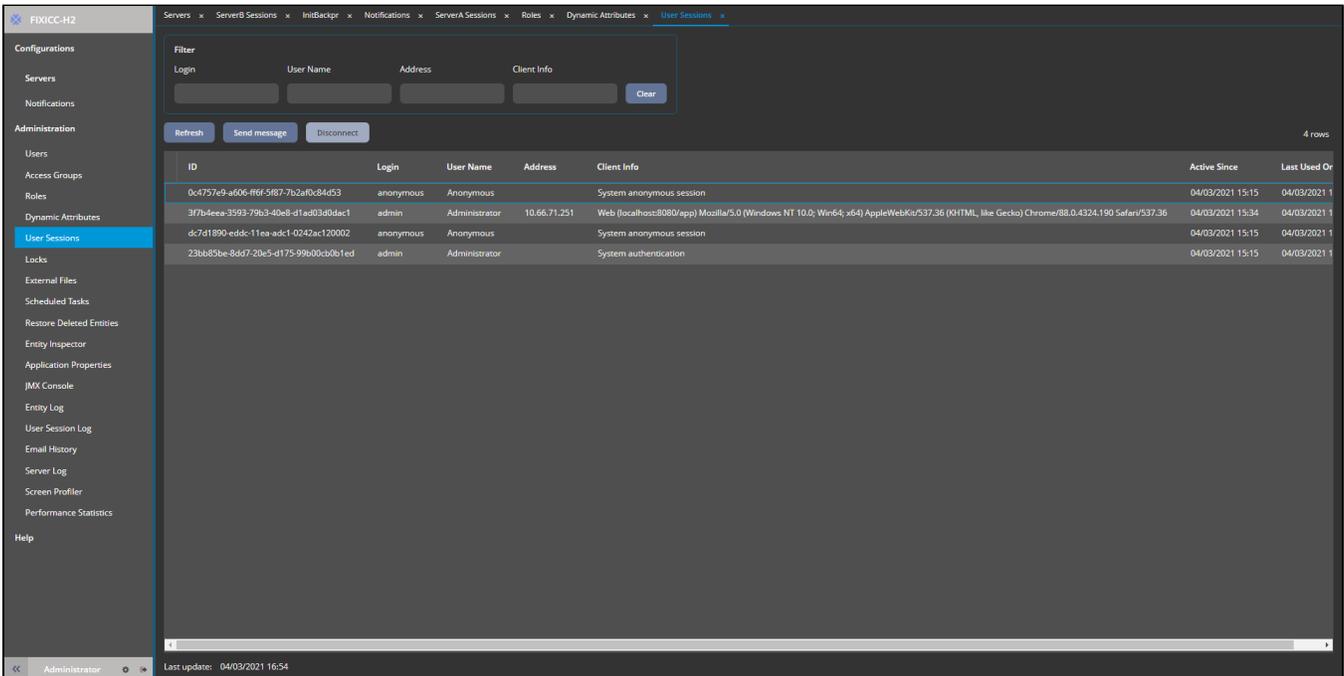


Figure. User Sessions.

Configuration for the specific situation to lock functionality.

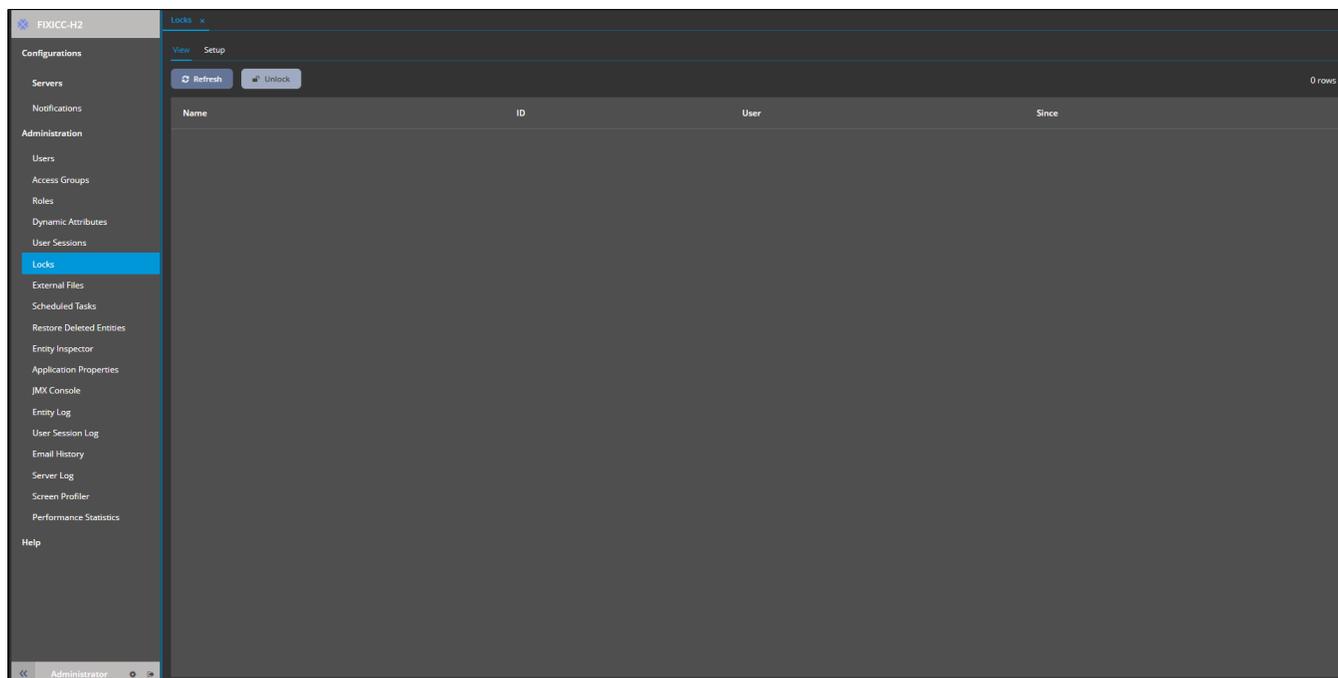


Figure. Locks.

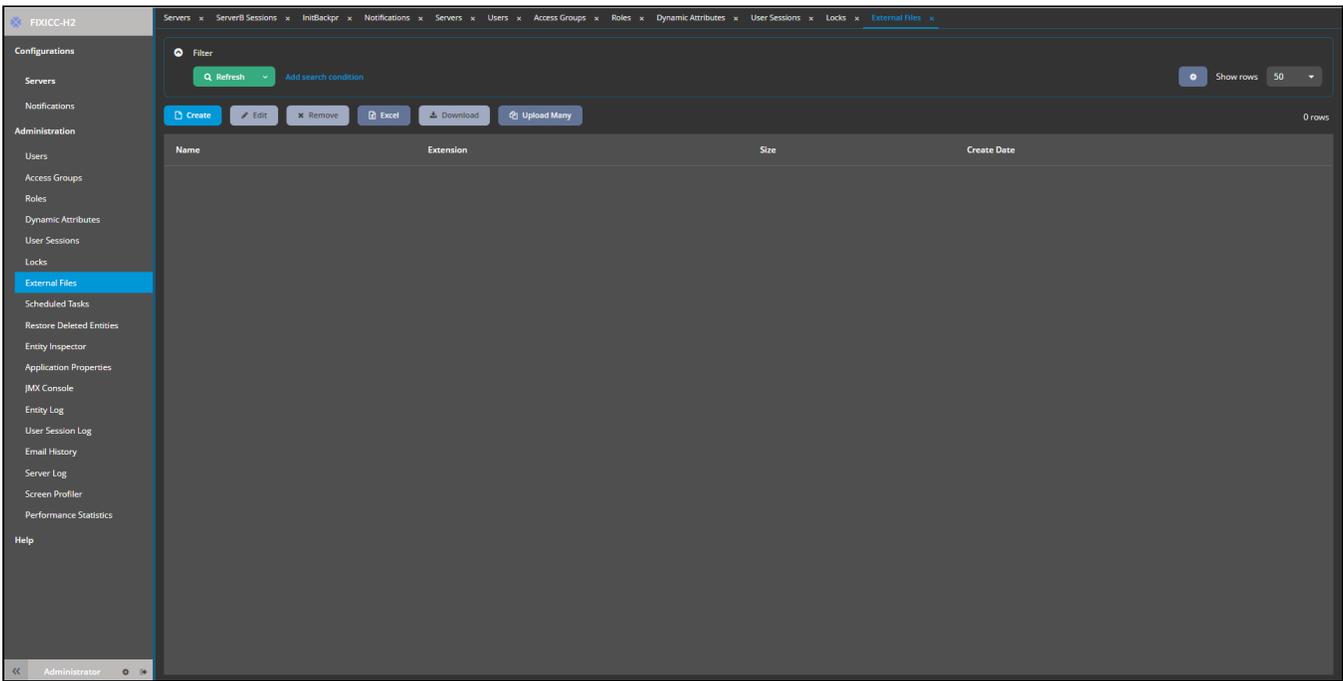


Figure. External files.

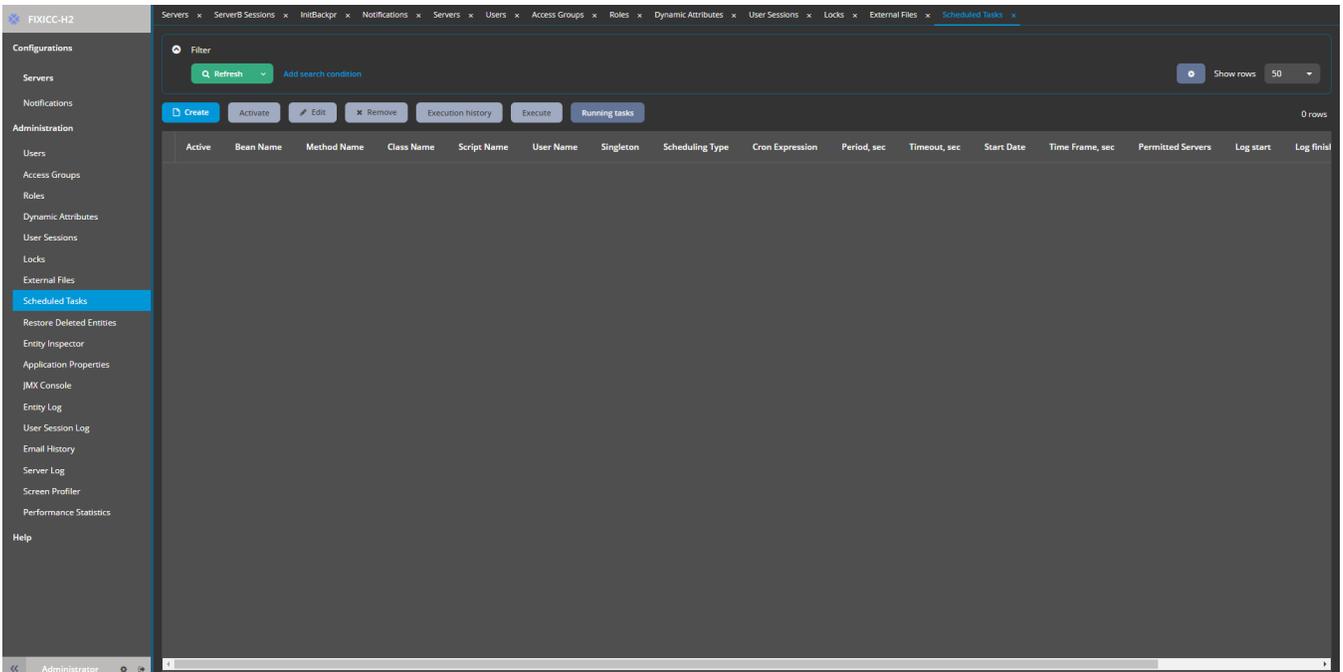


Figure. Scheduled tasks.

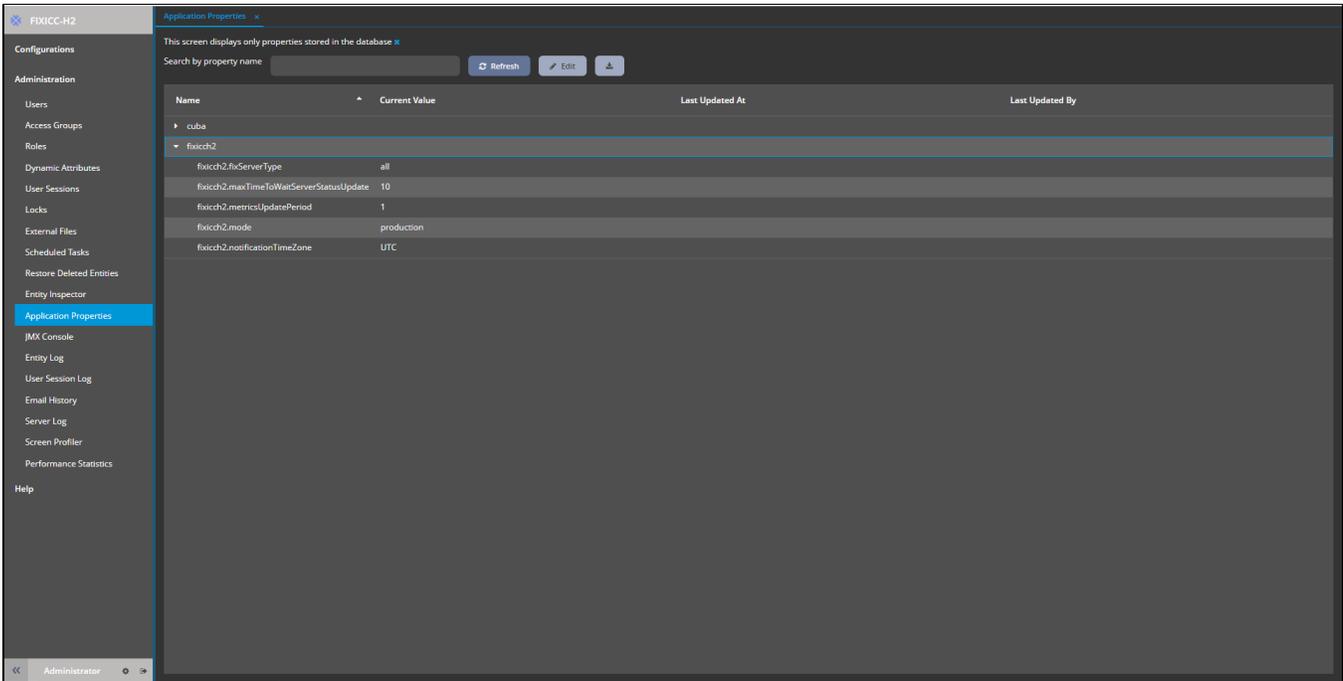


Figure. Application properties.

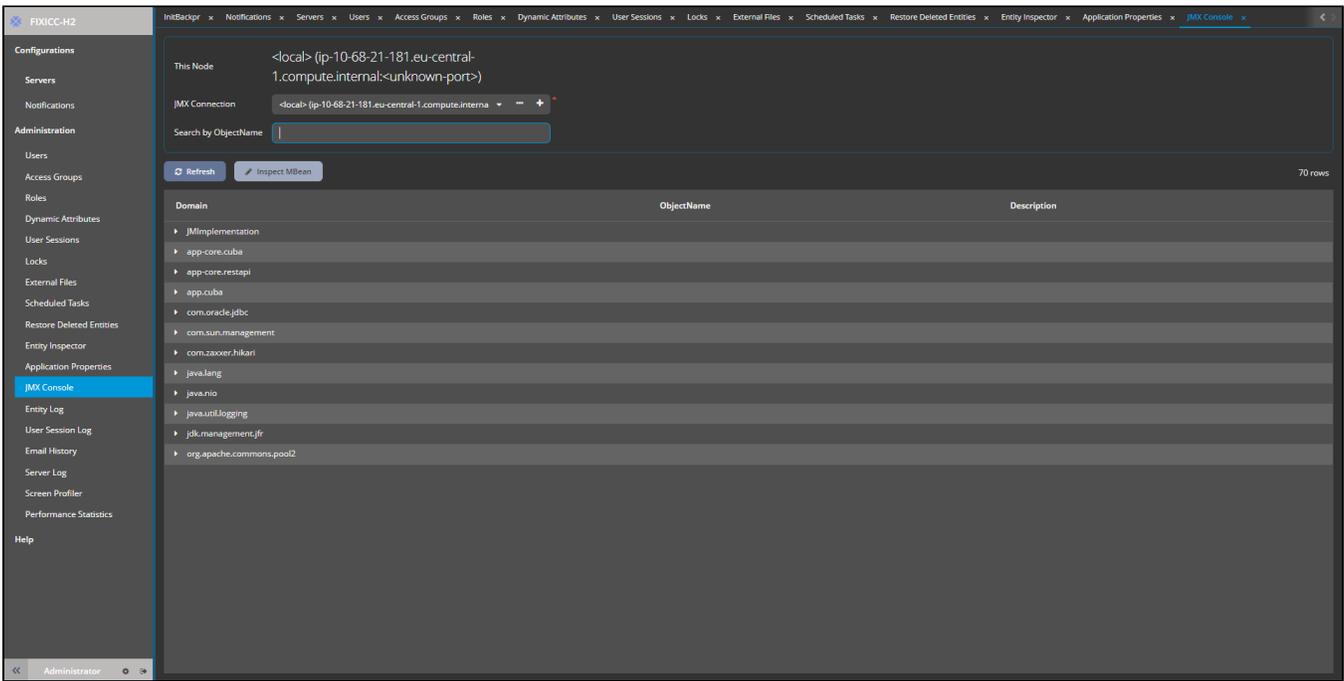


Figure. JMX Console.

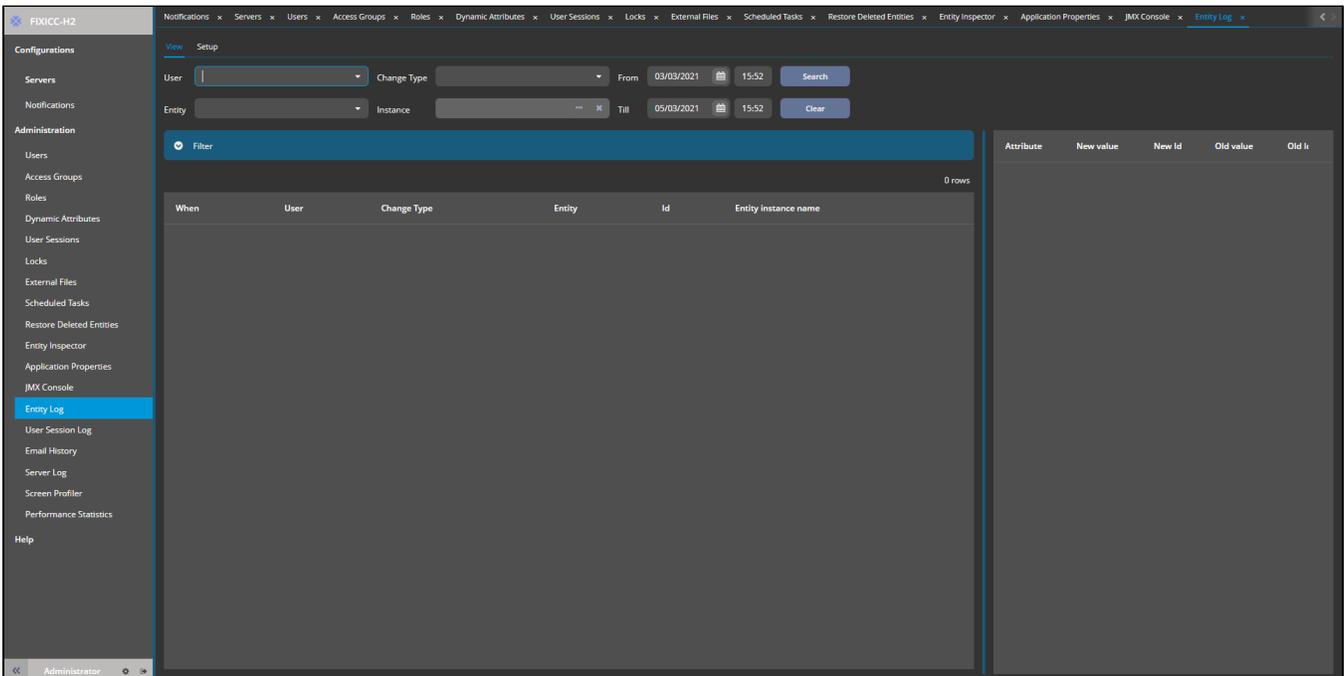


Figure. Entity log.

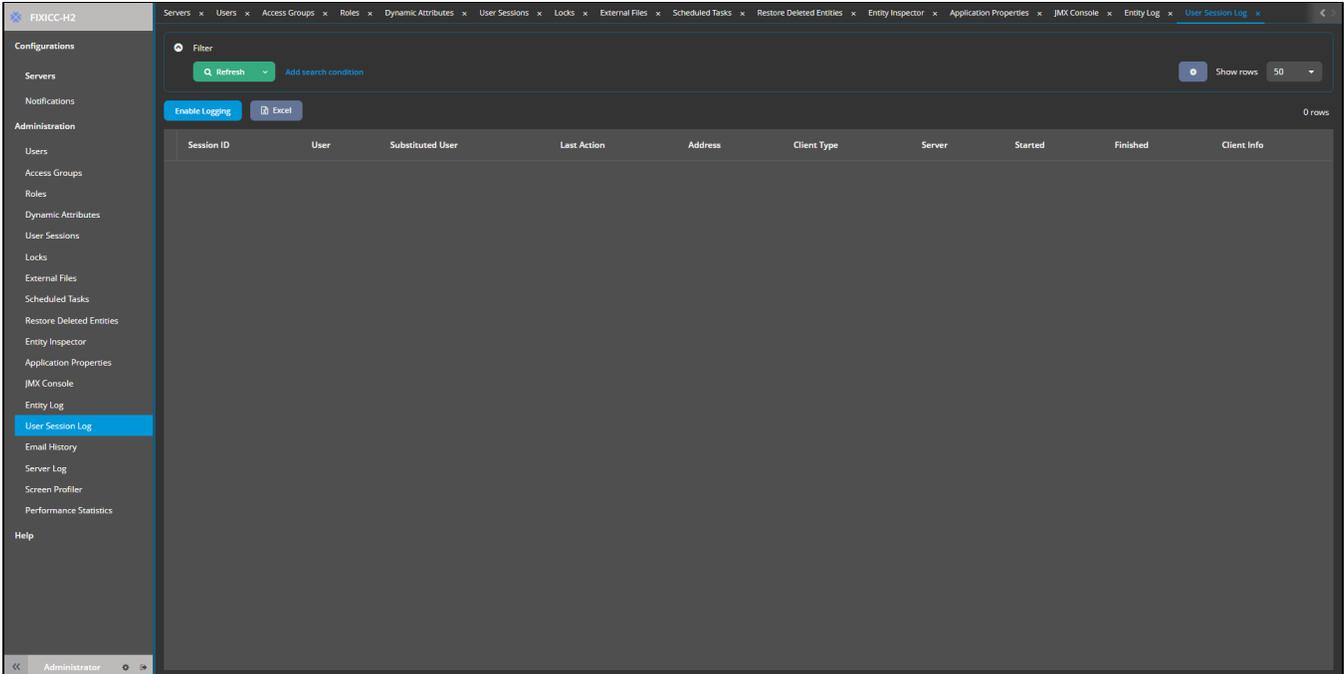


Figure. User Session Log.

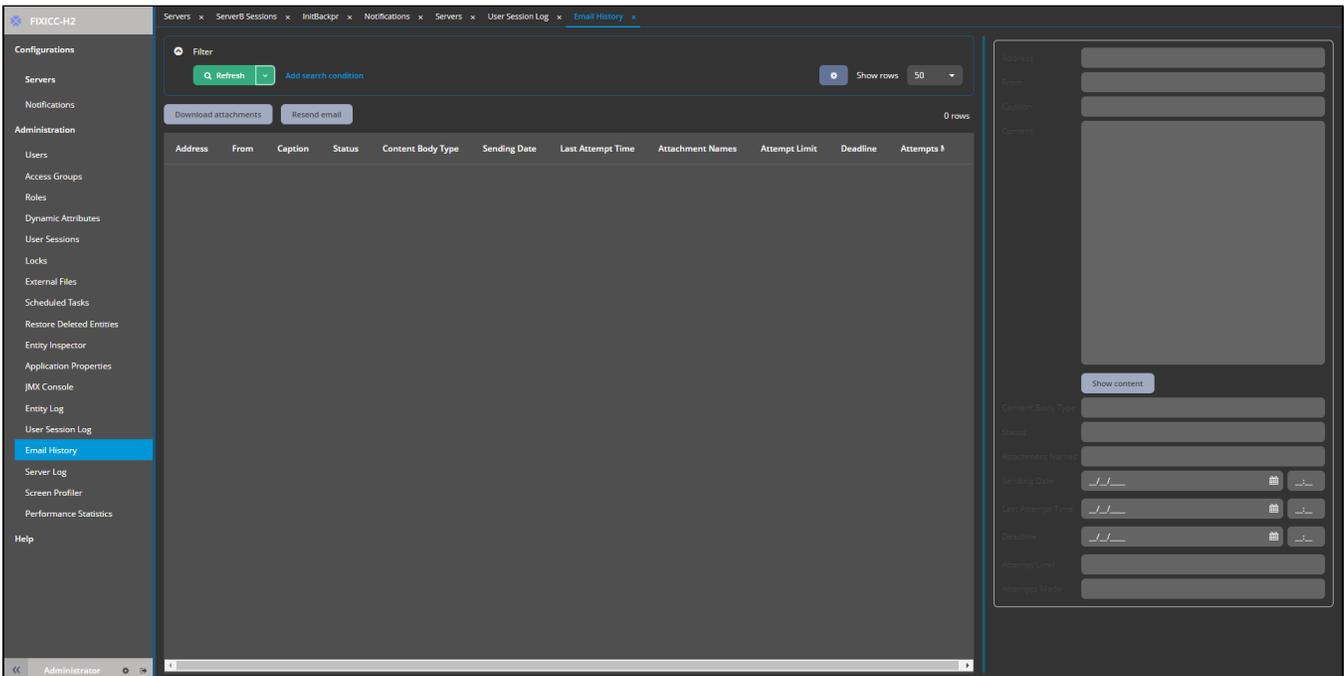


Figure. Email History.

As well, you have the ability to filter log info in the "Options" subtab ("3" label in the figure below).

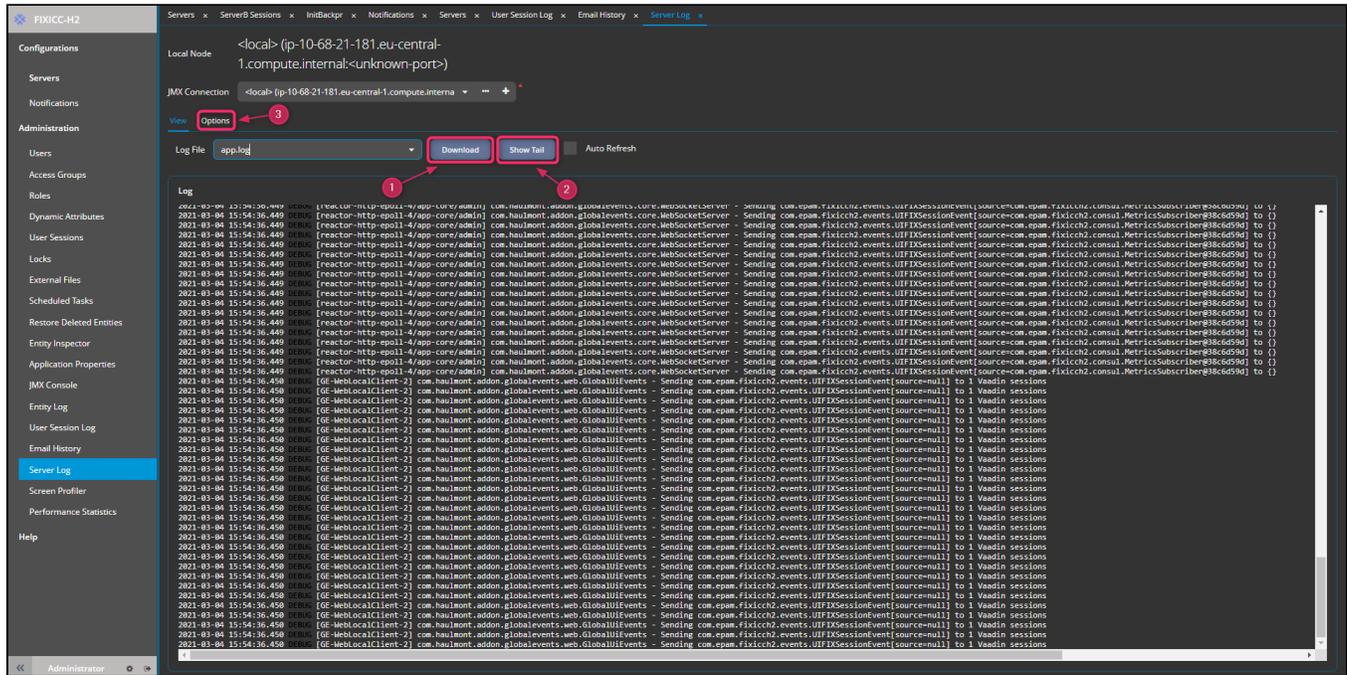


Figure. Server Log.

You can see more details about threads by clicking the "Threads" button ("2" label in the figure below).

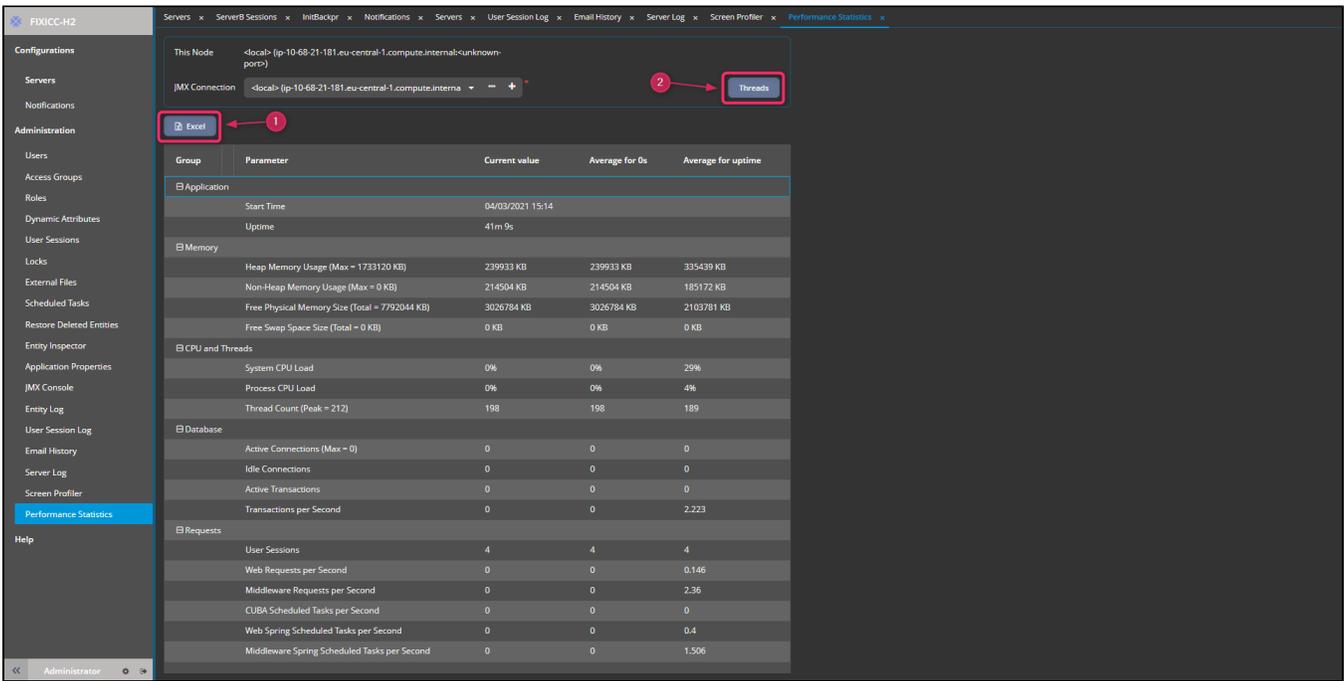


Figure. Performance Statistic.

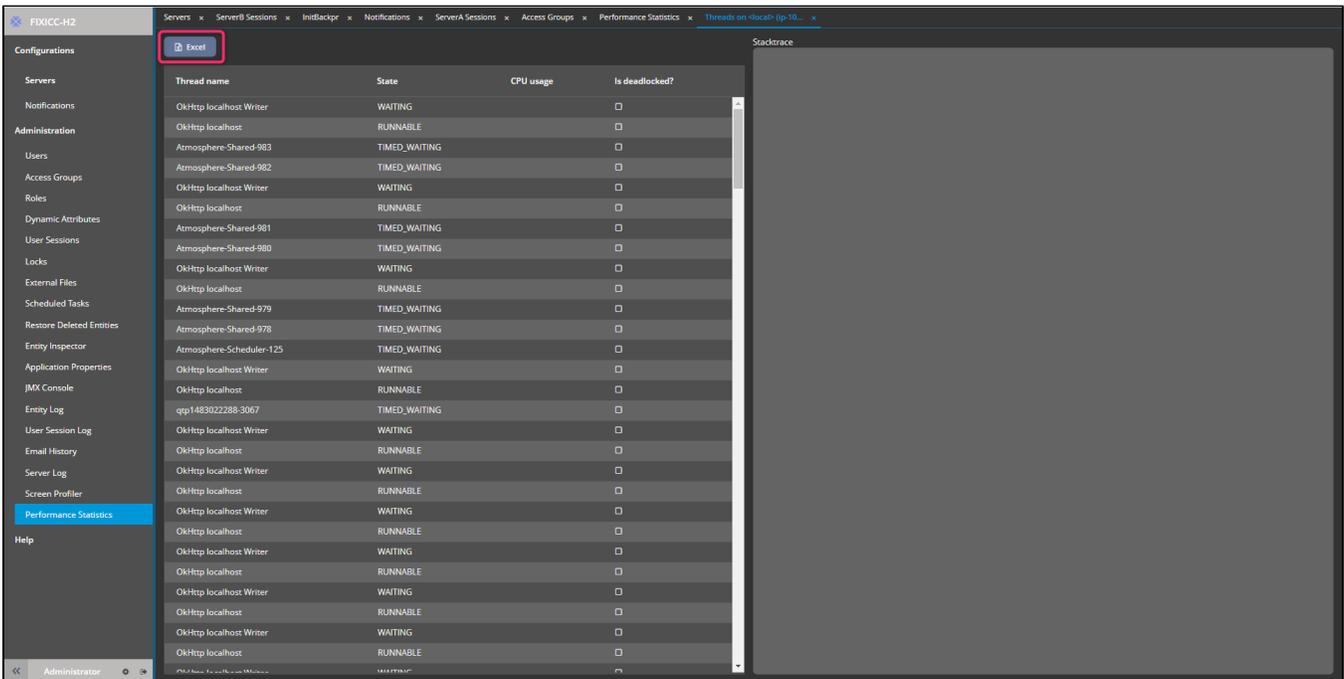


Figure. Thread's detailed info.
